

Non-rated Officer Selection Board packages are due 6 May, 2012 to the Force Support Squadron.

Individuals interested in meeting the Officer Selection Board must meet the following requirements:

- Be able to graduate from the Air National Guard Officer Training School (ANG-OTS) before their 35th birthday. This requirement may be waived.
- Possess, as a minimum, a Bachelor’s Degree. This requirement is waiverable if the individual has at least 90 semester hours.
- Must have taken and met the minimum scores for the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT). The AFOQT is scheduled through the Recruiting Office, 261-8541 and given at the Military Entrance Processing Facility. Waivers will not be requested for those members unable to meet the minimum AFOQT scores. Minimum scores are as follows:

Individuals interested in meeting the board must submit an application package with only the following items.

- Resume, including a cover letter formatted as outlined in AFH 33-337, Tongue & Quill (use the Targeted Resume format as outlined on pages 247 – 258).
- Letter of recommendation from current unit commander.
- College transcripts – if legible, copies of original transcripts are acceptable.
- AFOQT scores.
- Current USAF Physical Fitness Assessment with passing score.
- For officers wishing to transfer into the 132nd FW, they must provide copies of their last three OPRs.
